Exhibitor Requirements

- All work must be original.
- All exhibitors must exhibit and demonstrate their own work.
- You may sell only items that are listed and approved on your application.
- The appearance and ambiance of your booth is critical to the overall atmosphere of the Museum and Homecoming. We encourage an Appalachian/old-time appearance in both your dress and booth.
- Participate in and be available for all three (3) days, from Friday-Sunday, October 6-8, 2017. Inability to commit to all three (3) days may make it difficult to accommodate an exhibitor. - Event hours are extended this year, so exhibitor hours will be: Friday, October 6: 9am- 6:30pm (or later if preferred); Saturday, October 7: 9am- 6:30pm (or later if preferred); Sunday, October 8: 9am- 6pm

Booth Information

- Each space provided is approximately 10' x10'.
- This year we are offering 2 covered space options-- a covered shed or a white 10x10 tent. If you would like a covered space, please specify which you prefer. **Please do not bring your own tent-- all tents will be provided by the Museum of Appalachia.** Please contact Lindsey with any questions or concerns.
- In lieu of plastic banners, please use barnwood, tin or burlap materials for all signage.
- Exhibitors must furnish their own displays, chairs, tables and coverings.
- Electricity is not available.
- Booth space may not be shared or subleased.
- Tennessee State sales tax is the responsibility of each individual exhibitor/crafter; forms will be provided.
- Exhibitors will receive a total of three complimentary name badges; these are required for admission and identification for the duration of the event.
- Additional passes may be purchased for extra helpers at a discounted price.
- Sorry, pets are not allowed on the grounds of the Museum of Appalachia. No exceptions.
- Vehicles cannot be on Museum grounds during the event; complimentary parking is provided.

Setup and Breakdown

- All Exhibitors are required to check in at the Information Tent before setup.
- Exhibitors may begin setting up on Thursday, October 5, 2017 after 9am. All vehicles must be off Museum property by 6pm.
- Exhibitors must remain set up for the duration of the Homecoming.
- Booths can be dismantled after the event closes, at 6p.m. on Sunday, October 8th.

Booth Fees

- *Tent: \$295.00 or \$125 + 10% HC sales.*
- *Covered shed: \$225.00 or \$85 + 10% HC sales.*
- *Open air space: \$175 or \$50 + 10% HC sales.*
- *All sales commissions are due by 6pm Sunday, October 8.*
